

Dear Patient

COLDINGHAM BRANCH SURGERY AND DISPENSING SERVICE

I am writing to tell you that the Partners at Eyemouth Medical Practice have informed NHS Borders of concerns about their ability to continue running the Coldingham Branch Surgery and Dispensing Service.

This is because of:

- significant challenges in the recruitment and retention of staff within the Practice which make it very difficult to provide cover across the two surgeries
- the inability to offer patients a full range of clinical services from the Coldingham branch surgery which they feel is no longer fit for modern General Practice due to the limited facilities
- safety reasons when staff have to work alone in the Coldingham surgery because it presents risks to patients and staff

We are working closely with the Partners to explore these issues, and what measures should be taken to provide the best possible service to the whole practice population.

As part of this work we want to know the impact it would have on you if the Coldingham branch surgery closed and dispensing service ceased.

This would mean that all appointments would be provided from the Eyemouth surgery. Home visits, where deemed clinically appropriate, would continue to be provided to eligible patients. Medicines would be dispensed from alternative pharmacies in the area. Pharmacies may offer a delivery service for those who are unable to attend the pharmacy in person to collect their prescription.

If you rely on public transport, Borders Buses operate a service between Coldingham and Eyemouth. In addition, community transport is available to anyone in the community who cannot access transport.


